



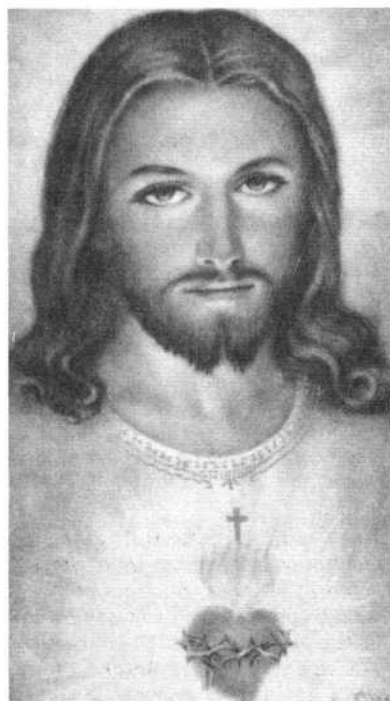

Excerpt from the *Cheerful Ascetic* (continuation of the thought from our April issue)

Throughout the centuries world-famous names were connected with Augsburg's past. The marauding Huns had sacked it. The Virgin, Saint Afra, had surrendered her life there in the fourth century rather than deny the Christian creed. Saint Ulrich had come in the tenth century to organize schools and raise the standard of Sacerdotal discipline; Augsburg always remembered him with grateful affection for his aid in repelling the Hungarian invaders at Lechfeld. Augsburg bankers, the Fuggers and the Welshers, made the city a commercial rival of Florence in the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries.

Welser money was being the organization of the Spanish caravan that Columbus led to the New World in 1492 and Fugger gold enabled the financially hard-pressed Emperor Charles V to carry on the government of his empire a half century later.

Augsburg won religious distinction during and after the revolts of Martin Luther. Melanchthon, the Protestant theologian, had come here in 1530 with his well-known Augsburg Confession, the first organized profession of Protestant faith . . .

## HOW MUCH GOD LOVES ME!!! (Father Grangell's Monthly Conference)

Virtue for June: Purity of Heart

Patron Saint: St. James, the less, Apostle

Text: Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God. (Matt. 5/5)

God created me for Himself, to be happy with Him forever. The devil wants my soul for his kingdom of hell for all eternity. My life is a warfare between these two powers, God and the devil. Father Seelos meditated daily on the question: Who is winning my soul? Where do I stand? That should be our meditation daily. Am I ready to die today?

See what God has done and is doing now for my soul! See the picture of the Christmas cards and the crucifix. They prove God's great love for me.

He gave me the Sacrament of Baptism to cleanse my soul of original sin and to open the gates of heaven. Receiving a sacrament means receiving sanctifying grace and that means sharing the divine life of God. At Baptism I become a member of the Catholic Church which entitles me to receiving the sacrament of Holy Eucharist, feasting on the Body and Blood of Christ daily if I so desire; if I have strong Faith, perfect love of God and appreciate sanctifying grace. When I go to confession I receive sanctifying grace. How God loves me and wants me! Again, He is present in the Blessed Sacrament to be my neighbor.

God protects my every second of life, giving me a Guardian Angel and a patron saint to go down the years with me.

My good parents are a gift from God. They taught me how to pray. They gave me a great understanding love of the Mass. I don't go to Mass on Sundays just because it is a church law. I love it. My home has always been a miniature church with all its religious appointments, including holy water to keep the devil away.

God gave me the Blessed Mother of Jesus Christ, the Queen of Heaven, as my Mother. She loves me as a mother loves her child. Nothing is too good for me, her child. I love the Rosary.

The ceremony of Baptism ended with the Priest commanding: Go in Peace and love and serve God.

The innocent growing child knows peace, joy and happiness. But when he begins to understand and realize that he can think and choose freely, the devil whom he renounced on his baptismal day begins to tempt him to sin. His most successful temptations are against the virtue of purity. He sends his emissaries in live people to work for him. Remember how he tempted St. Maria Goretti? She was 12 years old. A young man of 18 attempted to lead Maria into sin against chastity. She had told her mother previously: I would rather die a thousand times than commit one sin. She refused the young man: "God does not want it. It is a sin. You will go to hell!" He stabbed her to death. The answer to sins of impurity is NO. She could say: HOW MUCH I LOVE GOD.

Pray to be pure! Receive Holy Communion often, daily if possible, to live a pure life. Say three Hail Mary's morning and night, asking the Blessed Mother to keep you pure.
